Expressing yourself clearly

Your child took part in an OFF-TRAIL workshop aimed at **developing their ability to express themselves** so as to be clearly understood.

DID YOU KNOW?

Children learn a lot by observing adults and other children around them. During this workshop, the children explored the following effective communication strategies:

- Say how you feel.
- State your likes and dislikes (e.g., "I don't like it when...").
- Say clearly what you want.
- Use a calm, respectful tone of voice.
- Listen to others.
- Look others in the eye.
- Choose the right moment to say things.
